


EGI & EGI-ACE overview

EGI-ACE implements the **Compute Platform** of the European Open Science Cloud and contributes to the EOSC Data Commons


- Consortium:

 - 16 partners to deliver cloud, HTC and HPC resources

 - 21 providers: data spaces
