





Infrastructure, a Rapid Exchange Forum on COVID-19 developments is organized with national public health institutes, Ministries of Health, research institutes and universities as well as EU-level

stakeholders, to answer questions and discuss national experiences related to the COVID-19 pandemic. This allows a rapid exchange of information across countries to learn from each other's challenges and best practices, on e.g. vaccination/testing/communication strategies, reaction to new variants, mortality indicators, long-term pandemic surveillance and impact evaluations of the pandemic.
