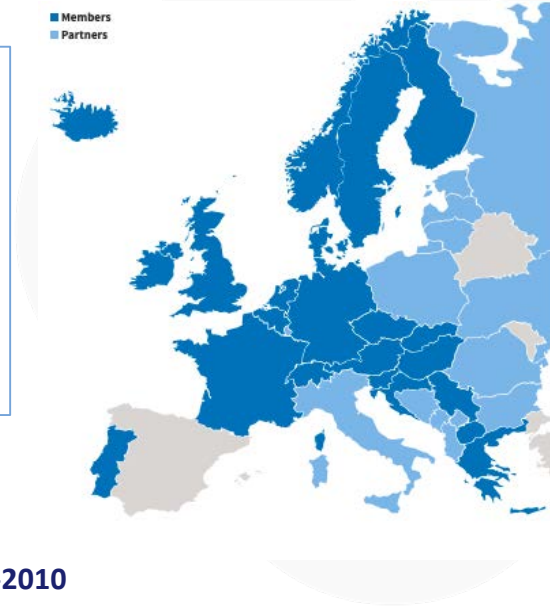

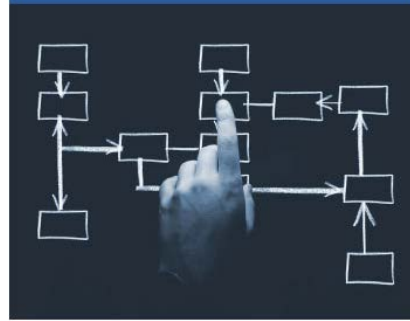
Discovering and using data
