Role of Eurostat

- **Eurostat** is the statistical office of the European Union
- **Mission:** to provide high quality statistics and data on Europe
- Eurostat produces European statistics in **partnership** with National Statistical Institutes and other national authorities in the EU Member States. This partnership is known as the European Statistical System (ESS).
- Available official statistics cover wide variety of aspects, from economy and finance, industry, trade and services, international trade, agriculture and fisheries, transport, environment and energy, science, technology and digital society to population and social conditions, including **health**.

European Statistical Recovery Dashboard

- On 17 December 2020 Eurostat launched the European Statistical Recovery Dashboard.
- The Dashboard contains **monthly and quarterly indicators** from a number of statistical areas, which are relevant for tracking the economic and social recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Dashboard was developed in cooperation with the statistical authorities in the Member States.
